The Blood Speaks! The Other Voice in the Courts of Heaven

"And all the people who belong to this world worshiped the beast. They are the ones whose names were not written in the Book of Life that belongs to the Lamb who was slaughtered before the world was made." (Revelation 13:8, NLT)

I. The Blood Speaks

- A. Fellowshipping with the Blood of Christ: Another dimension of it.
 - 1. The Church is not familiar with the Voice of the Blood of Christ.
 - 2. The Church is used to fellowshipping with the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit, and the Word of God, but not with the Blood.
- B. The Blood of Christ is speaking on our behalf in the Courts of Heaven.
 - 1. Jesus is not the only one speaking on our behalf in Heaven.
 - 2. The Blood is also speaking there on our behalf. (Hebrews 12:24)
 - 3. The Holy Spirit said, "If it speaks, it's alive."
- C. Abel's blood also spoke when he was killed by his brother, and God listened to it. (Genesis 4:10)
 - 1. Jesus' blood spoke better things than Abel's blood did. (Hebrews 12:24)

2. The moment Jesus dropped His Blood upon the earth, it became a weapon and a voice that partners with Jesus in the Courts of Heaven. (Luke 22:44)

II. The Voice of the Blood

"And to Jesus the mediator of the New Covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel." (Hebrews 12:24)

- A. There are two kinds of blood:
 - 1. The blood of Abel
 - 2. The Blood of Christ
- B. The blood of Abel: A victim.
- C. The Blood of Christ: A victory.
 - 1. You can't be a victim and walk in victory.
 - 2. When you approach the courts, you must come with the attitude of a **victor**.

D. The Blood is a witness:

- 1. "And there are three that bear witness in earth: The Spirit and the water and the Blood: And these three agree in one." (1 John 5:8)
- 2. The Blood of Christ is a witness for you in the Courts of Heaven, confirming everything that Jesus did for you. And it bears witness to it for you too, so you can declare it on the earth.
- 3. Unlike the statements of experts in courts on earth, when the Blood of Christ speaks on our behalf, it's not just an opinion, it's the truth.

E. The Blood speaks better things than that of Abel.

1. Abel attempted to obey the Father and he did obtain favor because he gave the right kind of offering, but <u>he and all mankind suffered from a compromised bloodline</u>.

- 2. The Blood of Christ, on the other hand, had no iniquity, no transgression, no trespassing, no sin.
- 3. So when the Voice of Jesus' Blood speaks on your behalf, it speaks that you are innocent on all charges and that the adversary no longer has a legal right to oppose, alter, or hinder your victory!

III. The Blood of Christ's Authority

A. Revelation 13:8 gives us the authority of the Blood of Christ.

"And all the people who belong to this world worshipped the beast. They are the ones whose names were not written in the Book of Life that belongs to the Lamb who was slaughtered before the world was made."

- B. The Blood draws its authority from *eternity*, not time. Therefore it is one of the most powerful weapons in the Kingdom of God.
 - 1. Jesus' death on the cross is not the actual birth of the Blood.
 - 2. His death is just the *entrance in time* of what the Father already did before the foundation of the world.
 - 3. Calvary is the manifestation of Revelation 13:8. Therefore, when partnering with the Voice of the Blood, you are partnering with a Voice that was speaking before you were born.
- C. The Blood, the other Voice in the Courts of Heaven, is the eternal witness—the eternal Voice that brings you victory in the courts of Heaven and on earth!
